WARNING - PENALTY APPLIES \$10,000 and \$100,000

1. Notice that by Order of the Terra Australis Grand Jury 40 order #4.

the highest authority on this land of Terra Australis:

2. All People may set up camp over night where ever they so choose.

3. You, as above named, shall not interfere with this Inherent Right to peaceful existence upon Our Land.

4. You shall not cause fear and/or alarm, nor any disturbance.

5. You are not permitted to issue any move on notice, fine or penalty.

6. You are not permitted tap on windows or any part of the vehicle or dwelling so used, nor shine a light into the sleeping areas at night.

7. To do so encumbers you personally, and the CEO of this Local Government, of a substantial financial penalty as per above.
